

## DAVID L. LEWIS

David L. Lewis practices law in New York City, concentrating on white collar and organized crime. He has represented elected officials, members of the Irish Republican Army, former CIA Agent Edwin P. Wilson, and General Manuel Noriega. After seventeen months on trial in The Pizza Connection heroin case, Lewis spent the next ten months in a trial involving alleged members of the Gambino crime family. Lewis also tried the first "Fatal Attraction" murder trial in Westchester County which ended in a hung jury. Lewis defended a former New York City Police Officer in the Dobbs Ferry deli shooting. He defended a double homicide in Orange County, as a capital murder case. The District Attorney in the face of 800 pages of motion practice, including a motion for a smarter judge, declined to seek the death penalty. His first capital client, a habeas corpus petitioner, lost his fight on January 21, 2004 in the State of Texas. Kevin Zimmerman's handmade clock sits on Lewis' desk. This past fall, Lewis with a team of lawyers, experts and mitigator, achieved two life sentences in a double capital murder in Federal Court in Brooklyn, New York.
